Information For Young People Staying With Bradford Nightstop

Bradford Nightstop provides:

- safe
 - free
 - one night at a time
 - emergency accommodation
- for young homeless people (aged 16-25) in the homes of trained volunteers or at place of safety in a local hostel.

Bradford Nightstop offers:

- A warm bed in a guest room, in safe and friendly surroundings. The next day you return to an agency to look for long term solutions or to try Nightstop for another night.
- Evening meal.
- Bed and breakfast.
- Facility to bathe/shower
- Information on other sources/agencies who could help.

Bradford Nightstop does NOT accept self referrals.

You must be referred through an agency. They can only refer you if you are there in person. Places such as City Centre Project, Information Shop For Young People, Housing Advice or a local police station can refer you. There are some useful addresses and numbers at the back of this leaflet.

Where are the hosts and how do you get there?

Your referral agency will discuss this with you and explain travel arrangements whilst taking the referral.

If I am offered a place with Bradford Nightstop, where will I stay?

Home of a volunteer

OR

Place of safety at BCCP Hostel

Time of arrival:	Evening, you are told the time when you refer.
Length of stay:	One night at a time.
Time to leave in morning:	Host will tell you what time before you go to bed. The time depends on how early the host needs you to leave.
Where will I stay?:	In the home of a trained volunteer who has been police checked. There may be other family members in the house. You will have your own room for your sole use. Some rooms in the house will be private.
Will I be offered food?:	Yes you will, in the evening and in the morning. The referral agency will ask if you have any dietary requirements.
Can I leave belongings?:	No, we are unable to store any items for you, for any period of time.
What about another night?:	In the morning you can return to your agency, or go to another agency. If you need another bed you will need to be referred again. It won't automatically be to the same place.

Time of arrival:	Evening, you are told the time when you refer.
Length of stay:	One night at a time.
Time to leave in morning:	Between 7.30am and 8am. Hostel worker will confirm the time after you have arrived.
Where will I stay?:	You will have your own room for your sole use within the hostel. You will not be able to use main hostel rooms and facilities.
Will I be offered food?:	Yes you will, in the evening and in the morning. Facilities will be available for making breakfast in the morning. The referral agency will ask if you have any dietary re-
Can I leave belongings?:	No, we are unable to store any items for you, for any period of time.
What about another night?:	In the morning you can have an appointment at the BCCP advice centre, return to your agency, or go to another agency. If you need another bed you will need to be referred again. It won't automatically be to the same place.
